





### The History of Brecht Stables and Therapeutic Riding

Brecht Stables & Dustin's Place was founded in name of my son, Dustin with Down Syndrome.

I was brought up with horses and used to spend the summers with my grandparents, who raised, trained and raced Standardbreds, also known as Harness Horses. I learned about self worth and respect by growing up with horses. I thoroughly enjoyed every second I had at the race track and with my grandparents- I learned more then I could have ever imagined.







I sat one day after quitting my previous job and it just clicked... why not match my passion of horses with my love for children with special needs? Soon after, "Dustin's place" was born.

Therapeutic Riding started in Europe in the 1950's. The achievements of Lis Hartel have been coined as the founding movement of Therapeutic Riding all over the world. Hartel, who not only



became the first woman to win medals in the 1952 and 1956 Summer Olympics in Dressage, she was also paralyzed from the knees down as a result of Polio.

Therapeutic Riding can help children and adults with all types of disabilities and can help improve balance, posture, trunk strength, self confidence, small and large motor skills, speech skills and hand eye coordination.

Experiential sleep away camp for kids and adults with special needs. We are a clinically informed camp where therapists, special ed teachers and nurses are your campers direct staff. We work with parents and camper's current therapist to achieve preset goals throughout the camp week. We have treatments teams each night to assess how the day went and write discharge summaries.

While the campers are learning how to shoot the yellow minion monkey jumpers with a bow and arrow, how to be a proper knight, taking hiking trips to find Big Foot and learning the stories of the great Native Americans on the rock formations and shooting blow darts at the pop-able paint balls or a 3-man sling shot over the bunk house with their friends, we are adapting every activity so the campers can be successful, make lasting friendships and improve self-confidence.

- Shoes with a leather heel such as riding or paddock boots (old tennis shoes can be substituted)
